Punishment for Misconduct/ Sexual Harassment

- Suspension from the Institution
- Debarment from appearing for the examination for a period up to three years.
- Rustication from the university.


- The Program was conducted by Miss. Shailakshmi Hegde, who educated all the women of institute about personal hygiene.

- Snacks and juice were provided to the members who attended the programme.



Academic information



FOR FINAL BDS COURSE

Final BDS course is divided into two semesters of six months duration each. Clinical training is given in all the Final year Dental Subjects for this academic year. Batches of students are posted in rotations.

Subjects included for FIRST SEMESTER:

- 1) Oral Medicines and Radiology.
- 2) Orthodontics.
- 3) Paedodontics.
- 4) Preventive and Community Dentistry.

Subjects included for SECOND SEMESTER:

- 1) Oral Surgery.
- 2) Conservative dentistry and Endodontics.
- 3) Prosthodontics and Crown and Bridge.
- 4) Periodontics.

Note: The students will take Part 1 (First Semester) Subjects at the end of first six months and Part 2 (Second Semester) Subjects at the end of the year.

ATTENDANCE:

80% of attendance is compulsory for all subjects, for Theory Classes, Practical, PreClinical and Clinical Postings.

EXAMINATION:

INTERNAL: Four Internal Assessment Examinations of 25 marks aggregate are conducted in each year for Theory, Practical/Clinical. These Internal Assessment marks are included in the University Examination.

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION:

At the end of each Academic Year University Examination is conducted. Marks allotted are 100 marks each for Theory and Practical/Clinical. Norms for Examination and syllabus as per Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

DISCIPLINE :

The college authorities expect every student to behave in a manner befitting a future Dental Surgeon. With this strict discipline is enforced and students are advised to attend the college in proper dress regularly. Any breach of discipline or ragging is viewed seriously and suitable action is taken against the students. All the students are required to wear apron (White Coat) when present in the institution.



Rules and Regulations for Undergraduate/ Postgraduate Students

Code of Conduct:

All students are advised to keep themselves aware of the Institute rules and regulations and should follow them strictly.

Dress Code:

All students should abide by the dress code prescribed by the institution. Boys should wear formal dress and shoes. Girls should wear decent salwar-kameez (if interested sarees) only and should have their hair properly tied up. They are not allowed to leave the hair loose. Girls are expected to refrain from wearing short kurtis with leggings combination in particular. Wearing jeans pant, T-shirts, is strictly prohibited. Both boys and girls should wear clean white aprons with name plates in the campus premises. To respect the sanctity of profession, please do not wear these aprons outside the college campus.

Punctuality:

Students are expected to be seated 5 minutes before the commencement of the class. Any student coming late will not be permitted to enter the class.

Attendance:

- Every student is required to maintain a minimum of 75% attendance separately for lectures and practicals, failing which the student cannot appear for the annual or university examination.
- In case of absence on account of illness, the Principal should be informed personally. On resuming the college the student should report to the Principal along with the fitness certificate.
- A chart of attendance record will be displayed regularly for the information of students so as to make them aware of incompleteness of attendance. Shortage of attendance will be intimated to their parents on phone/email.

Behavior:

- Students should show due respect and politeness towards all staff members at college and also their fellow students.
- Students should strictly follow the rules and regulations of the concerned departments regarding instrument sterilization and asepsis protocols patient management, allotted quota, maintenance of records etc.
- Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited and is a punishable offence. Students being ragged by seniors should bring it to the notice of the Principal or concerned staff members.
- The students should attend class-room teaching and are not allowed to shout (loud noise / talking loudly); being a source of distraction and annoyance to others is not permitted between the class hours or leisure time while they are in the campus. Students are prohibited from standing in person or in groups on the corridor instead they should go to the library or reading room to utilize the time in reading.
- Late arrival and early departure at or from a class are recorded as absence from the class. Students are not allowed to leave the institute during working hours.
- To switch off lights and fans before vacating the classroom.
- Students are expected to take proper care of college property and help the college authorities in keeping the premises clean. Damaging college property e.g. disfiguring walls, doors, fittings or breaking furniture, misuse of fittings, or breaking furniture etc., is breach of discipline, and the guilty will be duly punished.
- Students should not leave their books, valuables, dental instruments and other belongings in the classroom. The college is not responsible for lost property.
- Use of mobile Phones in the class rooms, seminar halls, and library is strictly prohibited. The mobiles will be confiscated if found in use and will not be returned.
- Smoking, consuming alcohol, drug abuse and any kind of misbehavior or any kind of unlawful activity within the campus is prohibited and will be duly addressed to the parents besides taking strict disciplinary action as per college rules and regulations. Any student found continuing with same behavior even after reasonable notice will be immediately rusticated from the institution.
- Students shall do nothing either inside or outside the college that will in any way interfere with its orderly conduct and discipline and to report all cases of impropriety and misbehavior to the college authorities.

Instructions for the Parents

Dear parents,

- Please update the rules and regulations of the institution from your child, college office or website.


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
