ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

The candidate seeking admission to BDS course must fulfill the following conditions of eligibility.

- 1) The Candidate should have completed 17 years of age, at the time of admission/ or 31 December of the year of admission.
- 2) I) The Candidate should pass the Two year P.U.C. Examination conducted by the P.U.C. Board, Karnataka State with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology or any other examination recognised as equivalent by the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences,

OR

- ii) The First year of three year degree course of a recognised University Physics, Chemistry and Biology including a Practical test in these subjects provided the examination is a 'University Examination'.

OR

- iii) B.Sc. with Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) or Chemistry, Botany and Zoology examination of an Indian University, provided that the candidate has passed the B.Sc. examination and has secured atleast 50% in any of the two subjects studied at the degree level and has passed the earlier qualifying examination and Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English.

OR

- iv) Any other examination which in scope and standard is found to be equivalent to the intermediate (10+2) science examination of an Indian University/Board, taking Physics, Chemistry and Biology including a Practical test in each of these subjects and English.

The candidate shall have obtained not less than 50% marks in aggregate in the sciences subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) at the qualifying examination or at a Higher examination However in respect of scheduled caste/scheduled tribe category-I the minimum marks required for admission shall be 40% in lieu of 50% for General candidates.

ELIGIBILITY FOR OTHER THAN KARNATAKA STATE STUDENTS

The candidates who come from outside, must approach the Registrar, Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore with following documents, for obtaining Eligibility certificate for the B.D.S./ M.D.S. Course.

- a) Photostat copies of Marks cards of the qualifying examination.
- b) Date of Birth certificate as recorded in the school/college.
- c) The Demand Draft for Rs.1000/- in the name of finance officer, Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore being the fees for issue of eligibility certificate.

ELIGIBILITY FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

Foreign/Non-Resident Indians, who have passed 10 + 2 qualifying examination with science subject i.e Physics, Chemistry & Biology and who have obtained more than 50 % Marks in aggregate at the above mentioned science subjects with English as compulsory subjects and whose qualification examination/Board/Universities are approved by the " Association of Indian Universities are required to apply for Eligibility on plain paper addressed to, "Registrar; Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences; 4th 'T' Block; Jayanagar, Bangalore-560041, INDIA. along with the following documents.

- 1) Qualifying examination (10+2) marks statement duly attested by Principal school/ college, concerned with English pass marks statement.
- 2) Date of Birth certificate duly attested.
- 3) A demand draft of 500 US Dollars or Equivalent Indian rupees in the name of Finance Officer Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore being the fees for issue of eligibility certificate.

The Non-Karnataka & Foreign student will have to produce eligibility certificate at the time of seeking admission to 1st B.D.S./M.D.S.course.

Foreign Students are required to get clearance and permission from the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, New Delhi before taking admission.
